List 3 recommendations for the conference to act upon:

1. Develop an evangelistic prayer strategy

Prayer is the foundation upon which all evangelism strategies should be built. By centering the strategy upon prayer, a church's strategy is connected to the real power-source.

- 2. Plan a minimum of two annual evangelism events
 - AME Day of Caring and Prayer Walk across the Conference on a Single Day for All Local Churches
 - Visit Community Senior Centers take a small gift or stuffed animal
 - Revival
 - Block Party
 - Door-to-door Survey
 - Ministry Evangelism Activity or Event
 - Children's Evangelistic Activity or Event
 - Revitalize the Sunday Church School
 - Attract students from other sources, after school programs, athletic leagues.
 - Serve breakfast
 - o Have Church School outside
- 3. Development
 - Review the AME Vision and Mission Statements
 - Include an AME History Lesson during Fellowship meals, Church Conferences, and auxillary meetings.
 - Bible Study and Prayer Meeting
 - Complete a SWOT analysis
